Simplify and simplify...

Again the concept "less is more", but adding a harder central block.

Door and separator profile in the same material, a white luxe combined with a central gold cuzco, which gives the necessary balance of color to the whole. The Luxe cuzco gold color increases the character of the combination and gives it a reminiscence of hardness and permanence over time.





Of simple straight lines

Seeking horizontality, the top cabinets feature doors with a horizontal grain and in a soft wood color Syncron Nocce 01 HO. The weight of the wood located in the upper part, making the kitchen have that horizontal direction that was sought.

On the other hand, a pure white such as Fénix Bianco Alaska, aligned with the lighting that appears under the wall unit, gives splendor to the composition.

the common denominator.

As in philosophy, there are currents of design that follow aligned parameters, with regard to furniture, there is a certain tendency to avoid the handle as a piece added to the door. There are those who consider it an uncomfortable element, both because of its use and because of the little value it contributes to the general image of the structure.

In the Klino model, simplicity in style and comfort of the grip are merged, by providing a hidden handle in the width or height of the piece.





Darkened backgrounds to highlight what is important

The contrast, the notable opposition between elements of the same image and in this case between the background and the element that you want to highlight, is a widely used resource when we try to distinguish part of the whole.

On this occasion, the gray of the walls, floors and worktop enhances the color of the fronts. On the other hand, the Almar model offers us a special strength with its bevels and staves, providing a certain retro memory that coexists perfectly with those dark background colors.

the metal fantasy

Simplified white background environments require a neutral ally that is in perfect harmony with the rest of the space. The Luxe range has all the necessary solutions for this purpose, as is the case of Luxe Plus Polar White, which in combination with Luxe Plus Osiris Graphite, achieve a perfect symbiosis to solve the idea.



Giving the best of each

Between the reminiscence of the past and the present, is this composition with fronts that beat on the groove made of the same material as the upper doors. The color 3699 NA has enough personality to dress up this kitchen on its own, but in combination with Luxe Blanco they project a special light.

To resolve the handle in this case, the 3730 handle has been chosen. This handle model opens just the right gap to pull the front in a balanced way as it is placed in the center of the door.










The N stainless steel handle that has been embedded in the door, undoubtedly produces the desired effect of looking like a rim profile. This handle is a resource that fulfills a double function, that of making the door handle disappear and provoking that sensation of horizontality of the gola profiles.


The use of the Zenit supermatt cashemire colour, in combination with the gray veined worktop, offers a perfect gap for the stainless steel handle that combines the grays and shines on its own..

No shooter in sight!

In the E70 system, the use of the N and N2 pull handle is very common. For the installation of the G78 and GM78 system, a height is required that cushions the dimension of the profile, so its measurement is increased to leave the maximum capacity for storage use. In the case of the E70 system with N and N2 claw handle, we avoid the increase in dimension, because the door assumes the application space of the handle and not the piece of furniture.

In this simple and elegant way, a "handle-less" effect is achieved without added complexities..

Moderation in the use of color

In this case, both the Zenit metaldeco cashemire color and the SYNCRON Aniversary 02 OAK are deserving of the title of serene, the soft tone of the cashemire as well as that registered touch and medium wood color of the Aniversary 02, assure us the sensation of peace that many of us seek. when you get home.

A twist

Fingerpull comes to curl the curl in the concept of the handleless door. The three-in-one design of this door solves the current kitchen line in one fell swoop. First of all, it does not need an added handle, secondly it avoids the joints of different materials and thirdly both the handle and the main plane of the door are of the same colour..



From the hand of an updated classic.

To pay tribute to the origins without losing potential in the design, we can resort to a framed door model, which brings back memories of those doors of yesteryear that had those bars on the perimeter that are so characteristic. Depending on the type of frame we choose, we will delve more or less into that classic fork and everything will depend on the type of frame.

The Ferreira model has a simple frame in terms of its volumes, but adds a slightly more sophisticated structural element, a narrow perimeter frame that contributes to generating that sensation of double parentheses.

It seems important to us to highlight the importance of combining a framed door with a classic character, with the rest of the elements with a flatter structure, which act as a brake so that the kitchen does not lead to a pure classic style.

In line with what we proposed in the previous composition, we want to propose a different stage in that fork of a certain classical reminiscence. The Sella model continues to be one of those doors with a smooth frame and ceiling, which has the particularity of having a rounded molding that highlights the miter joint of the corners. We will certainly get closer to that classic idea, the more sophisticated the frame molding.

We must pay special attention not to make the mistake, if it is not our intention, of selecting a classic-style door model and designing an environment that does not adapt to the new times. Trying to avoid that feeling of an old kitchen, instead of combining different styles to generate a renovated and elegant space, we suggest that, as far as possible, you have an image of the set of materials that will be part of the new environment, before confirm which of them will be chosen.

The elegance of black marble

This material, which imitates black Marquina marble, is a perfect ally to give sobriety and character to those sober compositions that use black and white as a combination.

We must highlight from this set, the reflection and hardness of the Luxe Plus White finish that makes it special, as well as that black mirror sensation of the Luxe Oriental Black. The depth achieved by using this type of material leaves no one indifferent.





Simple and functional

This type of kitchen responds perfectly to the definition of "functional", being described as, what is said of a thing, designed or organized taking into account, above all, the ease, usefulness and comfort of its use.

In this case, the stone that has been used in 60mm thickness increases the usual height by 40mm, achieving a total height of 890mm and highlighting the work surface due to its size.



Woods with dark green tones

Once again, oak as a support, a canvas with a dark background to receive a kitchen like the one we can see in the photograph. A greyish white furniture - Pavilion Gray 242 - with a very particular door such as the Douro model, characterized by that centered, rectangular and combined handle for overlapping doors.

As we can see in the photograph, the wall is a greenish-grey hue, which perfectly matches the tone of the door, since both colors belong to a chromatic range that includes those sinuous and hard greens.

Let's pay special attention when we use this type of dark colors to the natural lighting of the house. In the case of not having that lighting that we need, we will have to fill in with the appropriate light, choosing not only the number of points we need, but also their intensity and tone, selecting a warm, day or cold light depending on the results we want to obtain.

Toasted creams + oak + black

Deally, we could categorize the combination of these three shades (Savage Ground 213 + natural oak + black Luma with gray or brown parsol glass) because the strength of black and the personality of oak wrap the cream color as if it were a frame. roasted that is presented to us as the center of the composition.

We could say that it has a certain tendency towards a Nordic style, without reaching that idea of a rustic kitchen that is often represented in that style full of light, sober and natural colours.

The tone of the glass is available in gray or bronze, these tones are especially interesting if we want the transparency generated in the display case to reveal the interior in a grayish hue, which would favor cold colors such as white interiors. , gray or anthracite, or a tan tone that is very appropriate for warm colors, such as wood interiors.

The fact that the door does not require a handle allows us to focus on the figure suggested by the frame, without misleading with an added handle, a clean style that shines on its own.

The warmth of dark gray

We would never have thought about it, dark gray, a neutral color that we always consider cold, behaves like a warm color when it forms a contrasting set with oak. This idea is quite subjective, since if we look at the colors separately, it is still that dark and neutral color with an absence of vividness or color, but if we look at the composition as a whole, which is what our brain usually does, it becomes in an elegant color that leaves a good taste in our mouths.

In line with design trends, the Volga model manifests a simple style with that perimeter frame as subtle in its volume as the matching of the colors in the image. When it comes to combining materials and colours, they all must respond to a sensation, in this case a sober, elegant sensation, with no more shrillness than those that we can perceive through the dark gray of the door.

Let's not forget to take care of the construction of the environment and the chromatic range that we use to decorate the rest of the space, in this case some soft grays help to close the circle, because they are the true neutrals of the whole.









The perfect combo

There are combinations of materials, which from the naturalness of their essence allow us to live sensations with high loads of realism, but if we talk about a chameleon, about a wood that transforms and blends according to the environment, that is oak wood. We should not think of it only in its purest and most natural tonality, but from the possibilities it offers once painted. Matt or satin varnishes, dyes of a wide spectrum that show us dozens of shades, decapés or patinas that extract from it that noble and deep vein, are the inseparable allies of oak.

In this kitchen, the result of the combination between the dark gray Genil model, as the common thread for the most current neutral colors, and the Ródano model, color 2441V, it is a clear example of the versatility of oak, which adds the personality of its grain to which the structure of the door already contributes.

We can highlight from the set, the avant-garde touch of using a plain door with a framed door with a smooth ceiling without a handle, downloading a third of the set from added volumes.

The classics

This classic-cut oak wood kitchen is inspired by an industrial environment, which conveys a very cozy space, in which the extraction tube and the exposed brick wall stand out. The rest of the elements have been chosen taking into account the same retro cut, as is the case of the display case with digitally printed glass with the image of the Eiffel Tower, imitating the color of parchment with the tonality, a wooden bell for group filter and a square-legged table in white that links to the three-body window that can be seen in the background.

For a composition to make sense, it must have a main theme, which is usually related to a decorative trend, whether current or not, from which we will start to try to find the balance of the parts.

The true art is in getting that set of elements to convey a new idea, a palpable emotion or a sensitive vision of the world, either in a real or imaginary way ..

Elegance is in the details

In any furnishing, we must take care of the balance between forms in the same way that we take care of the color balance. In this case we can see that the dimension of the volumes is well balanced, occupying the spaces without invading them excessively, but taking advantage of the available area with determination. The combination of three colors is more than enough to get the most out of the set. The rusty pattern on the walls and floors provides us with a perfect background to highlight the oak color of the Vega model and the white of the countertop. As we have already mentioned on another occasion, it is very important to pamper the tone of the lighting, use a cold tone when lighting, it would diminish the strength that the oak provides with its grain and its warm tone.

In this type of inconspicuous compositions, it is important to choose a simple door, the Vega model lends itself perfectly to a small detail, the perimeter frame, to achieve that effect of elegance and simplicity. As Coco Chanel said: "Dress vulgar and they will only see the dress. Dress elegant and they will see the woman"
